Subject: 37th. MALE U17 EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP

Dear Sirs:

1. Following the information sent to all the affiliated European Federations through my email from 2018, May 4, I'm now informing the calendar of the event – *and some collateral activities* – that **FISR - Federazione Italiana Sport Rotellistici** will organize in Correggio, Italy, from Sunday, September 2 until Saturday, September 8, 2018.
2. We will have the participation of **9 national teams** - *Andorra, England, France, Israel, Italy, Germany, Portugal, Spain and Switzerland* - and the competition will be developed in two different phases:

2.1 PRELIMINARY PHASE

Taking into consideration the classification of the 36th. Male U17 European Championship – *which was held last year in Fanano, Italy* – the 9 teams will be divided in following two Groups:

- **GROUP A, with 5 teams:** PORTUGAL, FRANCE, GERMANY, ANDORRA, ISRAEL;
- **GROUP B, with 4 teams:** SPAIN, ITALY, SWITZERLAND, ENGLAND.

In each group the teams played a championship, all against all in one single round (*5 journeys in Group A and 3 journeys in Group B*)

2.2 FINAL PHASE

According to the classification that will be obtained in the “PRELIMINARY PHASE” of each Group, the teams will be then divided in the following two groups:

- **GROUP C, with 4 teams:** **The first two classified in each Group in the “PRELIMINARY PHASE” - which play a championship, all against all in one single round (3 journeys) - for the definition of the teams that will be placed from the 1st. to the 4th. places of this Championship;**
- **GROUP D, with 5 teams:** **The remaining teams - 3 from the Group A and 2 from the Grupo B, which play a championship, all against all in one single round (5 journeys) - for the definition of the teams that will be placed from the 5th. to the 9th. places of this Championship.**

3. REGULAR PLAYING TIME AND PRE-EMPTIVE TIE-BREAK

- 3.1** In the **UNDER-17 MALE category**, the effective playing time of the game is **40 minutes**, divided into 2 periods of 20 minutes.
- 3.2** **Except if WS Europe-RH deems it unnecessary**, in the 2 phases of this event, **the pre-emptive tie-break will be carried out for matches that finish tied**, with the execution of one or more "series" of direct free hits.

4. COLLATERAL ACTIVITIES IN THE “AUDITORIUM” OF THE “CENTRO SOCIALE XXV APRILE”

This Auditorium is located very near the “venue” of the competition and will host the following two initiatives:

4.1 DRAW OF THE 2018/2019 CLUB EUROPEAN COMPETITIONS

This important initiative will take place on **Saturday, 2018-September 1, at 11H00**, which will be transmitted in “live”, through “streaming”, by our TV Channel (*which is available in our “website”*)

4.2 MEETING WITH ALL TEAM DELEGATES

This usual meeting - *which is always handled before the beginning of all the competitions* - will take place on **Sunday, 2018-September 2, at 10H30.**


